Thank you for buying the **Submerged in Motion** Pack for Ableton Move/Note!

The pack contains the following resources:

- 16 Ableton Move/Note Sets each including
 - 1 Drum Rack with 15 samples
 - 3 Drift presets (1 Bass, 1 Pad/Key, 1 Lead)

Using the Pack with Ableton Note

1. Download the *.ablbundle* files onto your device.
2. Open the files with Ableton Move. That's it – enjoy! 😊

Using the Pack with Ableton Move

This process involves a few extra steps due to current software limitations. Here's how to get your Sets onto Ableton Move:

Before You Start

- **Backup Your Existing Sets:** If you have Sets in Ableton Cloud, download and remove them to avoid overwriting. You can re-upload them later.
- **Free Up Space:** Ensure there are enough slots on your Move for the new Sets. If needed, delete existing Sets *after backing them up locally using Move Manager*. Deleted Sets cannot be recovered!
- **Connect to WiFi:** Your Move device must be connected to the internet with Ableton Cloud enabled.

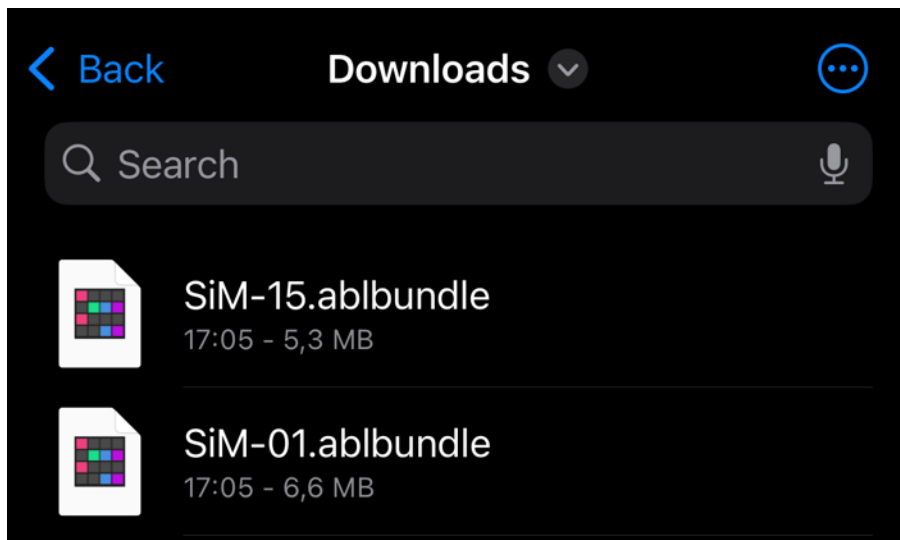

To import the Sets into Ableton Move please follow these steps:

Step 1: Download the Sets

- Transfer the `.ablbundle` files to your iOS device with Ableton Note installed.
- Locate the files in your **Downloads** folder using the Files app.

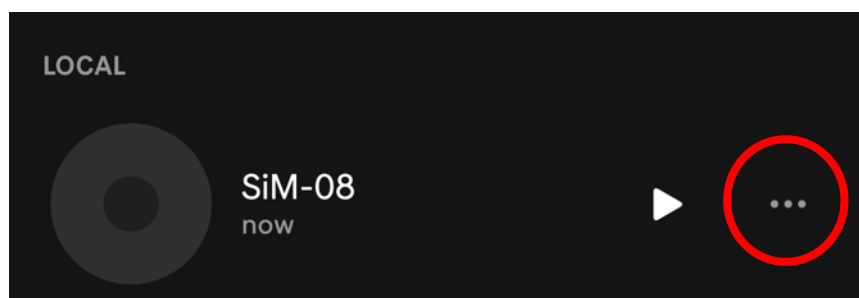


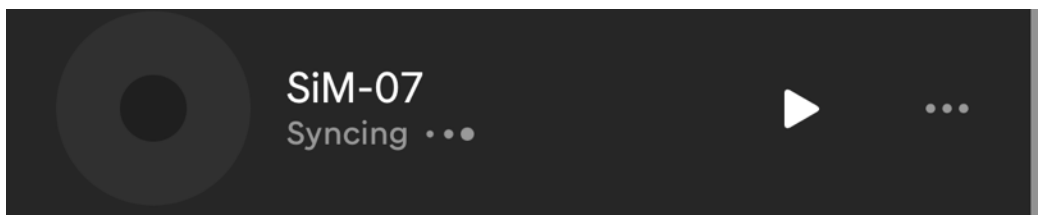
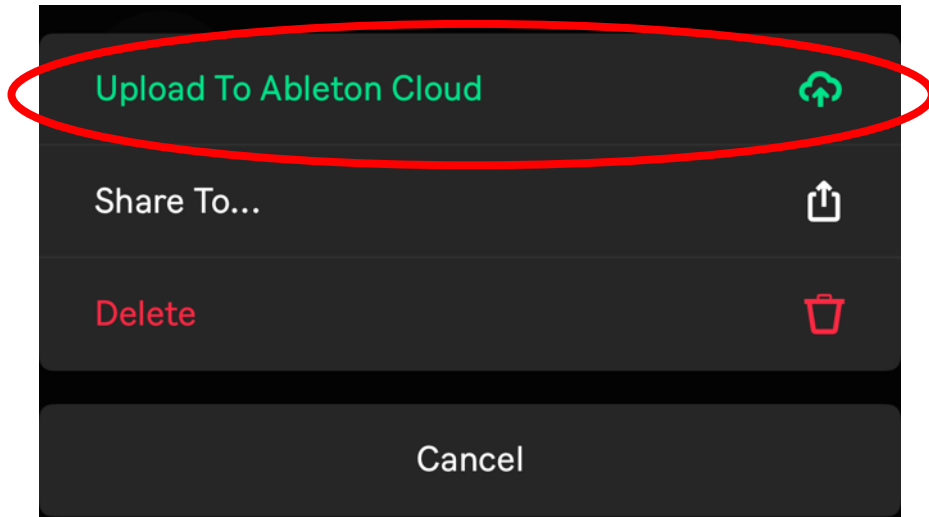
Step 2: Open Sets in Note

- Tap on each `.ablbundle` file to open/import them into Ableton Note.
- Each Set includes a Drum Rack, 3 Drift presets (bass, pad/key, lead), and example patterns.

Step 3: Upload Sets to Ableton Cloud

- Tap the `...` symbol next to each Set in Note.
- Select **Upload to Ableton Cloud**.
- Upload up to **8 Sets at a time** (Cloud supports only 8 concurrent Sets).





Step 4: Sync Sets to Move

- Wait for the Sets to sync with your Move. This may take a few minutes.
- Synced Sets will have a cloud icon above their filenames on Move.



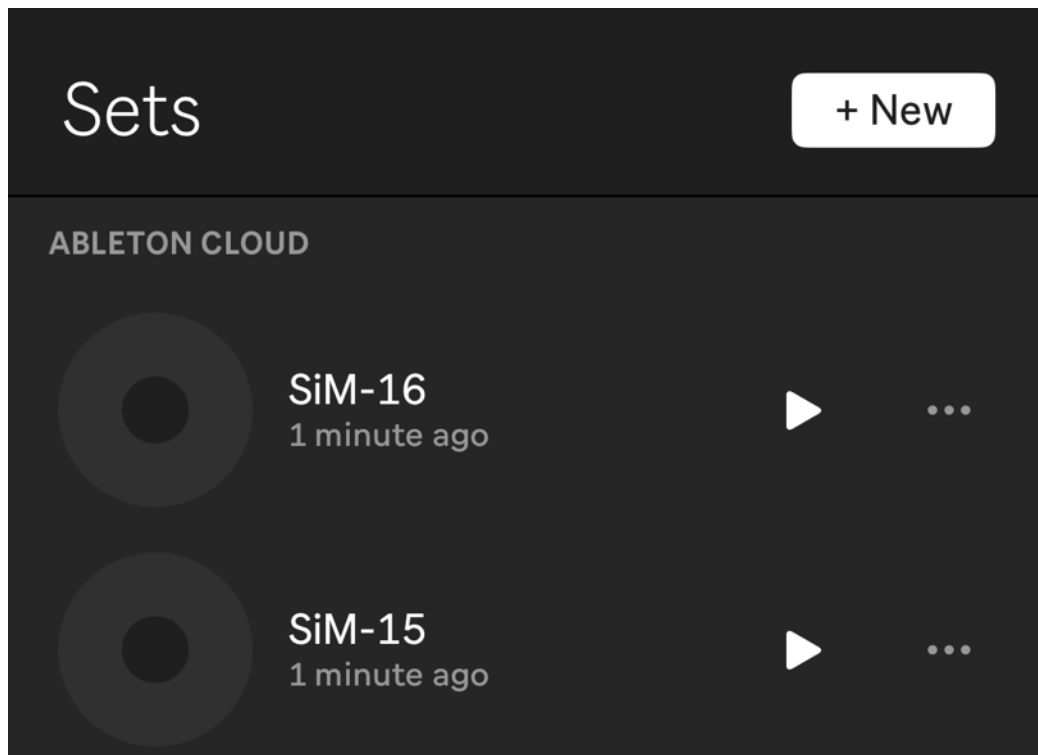
Step 5: Make Sets Local on Move

- On Move, while pressing the . . . button select a synced Set and choose the **Make local** option from the menu.
- Repeat for all 8 Sets, this will free up your Ableton Cloud slots.



Step 6: Upload Remaining Sets

- Return to Note and upload Sets 9-16 to Ableton Cloud.
- Repeat Steps 3-5 to transfer these to Move and make them local.



Step 7: You're Done!

- All **Submerged in Motion** Sets are now on your Ableton Move device.
- Enjoy creating with these evolving, dubby, and hypnotic sounds! 😊
