EXPLANATION

"Delete All Disabled Clips" is a MaxForLive device that let you remove all muted/disabled clips from your Live set with one click.

You can use it by:

- Simply clicking on the Delete button.
- Triggering it from Push.
- Or you can assign a Keyboard/MIDI shortcut to this button.


COMPABILITY

- This is a **MaxForLive device**, so it only works with **Live Suite or Live Standard with MaxForLive**.
- Works with Live 11, and Live 12.
- Available for both Windows and Mac..

INSTALLATION/SETUP

- Place the device into your Ableton Live User Library:
- Default User Library locations:
 - Windows: \USERS\[USERNAME]\DOCUMENTS\ABLETON\USER LIBRARY
 - Mac: MACINTOSH HD/USERS/[USERNAME]/MUSIC/ABLETON/USER LIBRARY
 - Allow Live time to analyze your library after adding devices. You can still drag and drop devices from the library in the meantime.

You can place the device into any track in your project.



1. Delete Button

Use this button to delete all the muted/disabled clips.

2. Set Mode for Specific Views

Decide whether the device should delete the clips from Arrangement View, Session View, or both.

3. Affect All Tracks or Selected Tracks Only

The device can operate on:

- All Tracks: Applies changes across your entire Live Set.

- Selected Tracks Only: Applies changes only to the selected tracks.

(The device don't have to be on the selected track. Just assign a keyboard shortcut to the Delete button to execute it remotely.)
