## Introduction

Welcome to Melodic Movement – a deep, lush and expressive sound pack, carefully crafted by Miles Kvndra. With tailor made preset versions optimized for Ableton Move, Ableton Push 3 Standalone and Ableton Live, it provides you with a vast palate of characteristic arps, basses, keys, leads, and pads, as well as 2 drum racks for drum sounds, percussive sounds and FX. Dive into the world of Melodic Techno, Organic House, Deep House or various ambient genres and explore moving, characterful sounds that add depth and motion to your music productions.

Key characteristics:

## Installing Ableton Move Presets

1. To load the presets on your Ableton Move, you will have to go via your web browser to your Move Manager (learn more on that [here](#)).

2. Once you are connected to your Move Manager, you click on "Presets". Then you can just drag & drop the Folder "MM Move Presets" to your Move. Alternatively, you can click the arrow besides the "Upload" button and select "Upload folder", to upload all the sounds to your Move.

## Installing Push 3 SA & Ableton Live (P&L) Drift Presets

### Ableton Live

1. In Ableton Live you can just drag the folder "MM Push 3 SA & Ableton Live (P&L) Drift Presets" to wherever you want to save it in your User Library or any other place on your hard drive. To load a preset, just navigate in Ableton Live's browser to the location in which you stored it and double click the sound you want to load or drag & drop it into your Ableton Live project.

### Ableton Push 3 Standalone

1. Once your Push 3 SA is connected to your Ableton Live, you can drag and drop the presets from your User Library to your Push 3 Standalone. Drag the full folder, hover over the "Push" icon under "Places" in your Ableton Live Browser, and then drop it to wherever you want to save it on your Push Standalone. ## Installing Push 3 SA & Ableton Live (P&L) Drum Racks

### Ableton Live

1. Save the project "Melodic Movement Drum Racks Project" in the folder "MM Push 3 SA & Ableton Live (P&L) Drum Racks" on your computer and open the project. Then you click on the "save" icon to save both Drum Racks in your Library to use. Make sure the samples from the "Samples" Folder are stored in your User Library as well.

### Ableton Push 3 Standalone

1. Load the project "Melodic Movement Drum Racks Project" in the folder "MM Push 3 SA & Ableton Live (P&L) Drum Racks" on your Push 3 SA and open it there. In Device Mode, hold the Save button and press the upper display button above the Rack title. This will save the preset to your User Library, and the samples will be imported with it. The next time you open the included presets, the samples will be available and work as expected. After saving presets to Push using this method, the original "Melodic Movement Drum Racks Project" can be deleted and the preset will still work.
